INTEGRATING AND RESPECTING YOUR ENVIRONMENT

The Hub blends harmoniously into an exceptional environment, embracing the natural contours of the site and blending in elegantly. This responsible approach is based on the three fundamental pillars of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), each expressed in an exemplary way.

ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITMENT

The Hub takes an ecological approach on several levels:

Respectful architecture: 6,000 m² green roof with local plant species to preserve biodiversity. **Energy performance:** 1,000 m² of photovoltaic panels, heat pumps for heating/cooling, and reinforced insulation to reduce energy consumption.

Beekeeping: the presence of beehives contributes to pollination and local biodiversity.

Pronatura commitment: preservation of ecosystems, reintroduction of endemic species and sustainable ecological initiatives.

Soft mobility: partnership with the NStCM to facilitate access to the site and reduce the carbon footprint, with charging points for electric vehicles.

SOCIAL COMMITMENT

The well-being of the Hub's employees and visitors is a priority:

Optimal working conditions: modern, ergonomic spaces create a working environment conducive to personal and professional fulfillment.

Coaching: constant support enables employees to develop their skills and actively contribute to the Hub's reputation.

Event spaces

RISE TO THE HEIGHTS OF YOUR AMBITIONS

Flexibility, modularity and elegance are the watchwords of the 3,000 m² of event spaces, designed to create tailor-made, inspiring events with the utmost care.

The excellence of the setting, with its breathtaking views of Lake Geneva and Mont Blanc, is matched only by the quality of the immersive technology used.

The auditorium is interconnected with the Hub's various event spaces (auditorium, rooms, studio) as well as with the medical technical platform (bunkers, operating theater), enabling simultaneous events in these different spaces.

It also offers the possibility of staging hybrid or remote events on an international scale. On the same floor, a radio, TV and podcast studio equipped with the latest technology can produce high quality live or recorded content and broadcast events.

Surrounding it, the conference area provides a warm, cosy ambience.

The space is topped by a Garden of the Five Senses: an elegant 6,000 m² planted roof top offering an unforgettable sensory experience.

Conferences, symposia, forums... although the facilities have been designed primarily for medical events, the Hub is also an ideal venue for any type of event, whatever the sector of activity.



Architecture

ONE PROJECT, TWO ARCHITECTS

This uniquely contemporary building is the brainchild of architect Gabriele Rossi and architect and interior designer Kristian Gavoille. Together they have designed a unique venue that harmoniously blends modernity and nature, creating an elegant and refined setting for memorable events.

Designed to blend in perfectly with the natural curves of its surroundings, the building opens out generously onto the surrounding countryside, offering luminous spaces that invite contemplation. Inside, the use of noble, high-quality materials enhances every detail, combining refined design with enveloping warmth. This unique blend of contemporary architecture and welcoming atmosphere creates a setting where every guest feels both inspired and soothed.

The interior decor is a tribute to knowledge, with a monumental library as its centerpiece, both a striking aesthetic feature and a symbol of the importance of sharing ideas and knowledge. The place exudes a warm, 'living' atmosphere that encourages dialogue and exchange, creating an environment conducive to creativity and innovation.

The Genolier Innovation Hub is much more than a space, it's an immersive experience where nature meets design, and where each event becomes unique, imbued with elegance and serenity.



GABRIELE ROSSI ARCHITECT

After graduating from Columbia University in New York in 1985 with a Master's degree in architecture and urban planning, he worked for four years at Cooper Eckstut. Responsible for planning the new Battery Park City district, he worked alongside architects such as Richard Meyer, Bob Stern and Kenneth Frampton.

In 1989, he became an assistant to Professor Erwing Galantay's chair of urban planning at the École polytechnique fédérale de Lausanne, where he obtained the equivalence of the EPFL diploma and joined the Société des Ingénieurs et Architectes. At the same time, he set up his own architecture and urban planning firm, Archilab, and won several architectural competitions. This quickly led to public commissions, including neighbourhood plans for local authorities and the construction of harbours and museums for the canton.

In 2001, he collaborated with Mario Botta on the Bodmer Foundation Museum in Geneva.

In 2019, he was approached by the teams of the future Genolier Innovation Hub, with a view to creating an iconic space that would be fluid and transparent, and perfectly integrated into the landscape.



KRISTIAN GAVOILLE INTERIOR DESIGNER

Architect D.P.L.G-Designer, he also teaches at the École Nationale Supérieure des Arts Décoratifs de Paris and the Camondo school. From 1986 to 1991, he worked with Philippe Starck on numerous projects around the world. In 1992, he was awarded the designer of the year prize by the city of Paris in recognition of his talent and his vision of modernity.

His reflections on space and materials have enabled him to work for many renowned clients in a wide variety of fields

Kristian Gavoille designed the entire interior architecture of the Genolier Innovation Hub, bringing warmth, softness and naturalness to an elegant, uncluttered approach.













AUDITORIUM

EMBODYING THE QUINTESSENCE OF EXCELLENCE

The centrepiece of the Hub, it is its quintessence.

Its telescopic shape, open to the lake and the Alps, gives it a singular character, perfectly recognisable from the outside. Inside, the unique panoramic view can be enjoyed from the stage, flanked by a spectacular 6-meter high bay window.

The quality of the immersive experience is another outstanding feature.

Equipped with a motorised LED screen on stage with LED panels on the sides, our auditorium offers a three-dimensional 270-degree experience, significantly improving overall impact and engagement.

With a capacity of up to 300 people, it offers an inspiring and unique setting for events of all kinds: conferences, symposia, sitdowns, etc.



Bathed in natural light, the 20 meeting rooms are specially designed to host your meetings, seminars, presentations or training courses.



CONGRESS AREA

OPENING UP TO THE BEST PROSPECTS

Situated at the heart of the Hub, enjoying natural light and exceptional views of the mountains and Lake Geneva, the Conference Zone is a fully modular space. Conceived as a place for exchanging ideas and collaborating, this space is completely open and flexible. With its bar area and close proximity to the Hub's restaurant, it has the capacity to host all types of events: cocktail reception, gala dinner, afterwork, press conferences,

but is also ideal for organising trade shows, demonstration stands or promotional events. Adjacent to the auditorium, this area can be reserved for coffee breaks or standing lunches during an event taking place in the auditorium or any other area of the Hub. It can accommodate up to 500 people and has a cloakroom and secure, connected lockers for recharging computers and smartphones.

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

PUTTING CONTENT AT THE CENTER

Modern and bright, the recording studio has been designed for podcast production, radio and television programmes, live or recorded.

Furnished with care and expertise, it is equipped with all the latest technology. Connected to the auditorium, it offers the possibility of broadcasting a program or interview live to a wider audience.

Available for use for half the day by demand or full day, the studio enables the creation of high-quality audiovisual content, particularly for events organised within the Hub. It can accommodate up to 6 people.



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GARDEN OF THE 5 SENSES

CULTIVATING A SYMBIOTIC RELATIONSHIP WITH NATURE

Spread over a vast area of 6,000 m², the Hub's green roof is a space for exchanges devoted to therapies and well-being.

Open to all, this roof terrace has been designed around the five senses: sight, hearing, taste, smell and touch, putting people at the heart of its concerns.

An experience in harmony with the environment, which the green roof helps to preserve through its harmonious integration and the choice of endemic plant species, encouraging biodiversity. The Hub's 5 senses garden is also first and foremost a space for living and events, hosting aperitifs on the roof, sit-down dinners, barbecues, fondues in a transparent igloo, artistic performances and more, depending on the season, all with a breathtaking view of Lake Geneva and Mont Blanc.

Its direct access to the Hub's training operating theatre and auditorium, as well as its direct vehicle access ramp, make it an ideal place to hold an event.





Whether it's a temporary exhibition, a vernissage, an


artistic performance or a product launch, this space is an invitation to all kinds of creativity, both in the medical and cultural worlds.




